# PLACEMENT POLICY

## PLACEMENT Assistance

## Eligibility Criteria for Campus PLACEMENT

The following criteria shall be utilized to determine the eligibility of candidates for participation in the campus placement process.

**1) Eligibility & Conduct:** Students must have no academic backlogs, 75% minimum attendance, and adhere to the institute's Code of Conduct. Those on the 'Red List' for misconduct are permanently disqualified from placements.

**2) Participation & Interview Rules:** Participation in all training and placement activities is mandatory. Students are allowed up to three interview attempts. Accepting an offer and not joining without valid approval results in disqualification from future placements.

**3) Declaration & Disclaimer:** Placement does not guarantee employment. All students must sign a declaration accepting the rules and acknowledging that final hiring decisions rest with the recruiting companies.

# CODE OF CONDUCT

## PURPOSE & VALUES

This Code of Conduct aims to instil academic integrity, ethical behaviour, environmental responsibility, inclusiveness, and professionalism. It supports national regulatory frameworks and global values for sustainability, gender equity, and social responsibility, ensuring PIMSE students become conscientious global citizens and sustainable business leaders.

## DRESS CODE

Students must wear formal attire or institute-approved uniform on all working days. Attire should reflect Indian cultural values, decency, and professionalism.

Boys: Full-sleeve shirts and trousers (jeans/t-shirts not allowed). Girls: Salwar-Kameez (knee-length) or Saree with sleeved blouse (Western casuals are discouraged). On special occasions (e.g., Sustainability Day, Green Campus Initiatives) – students are encouraged to wear eco-friendly or khadi garments to promote local and sustainable fashion.

## IDENTITY CARD

Mandatory to wear within campus. Must be produced on request. Loss must be reported; a duplicate will be issued after written request and fee. Non-compliance attracts a fine of ₹50 per day.

## LIBRARY ETHICS

- Uniform and ID card are compulsory for access.
- Limit of 3 books for 7 days. Late fine: ₹1/day.
- Reference books, journals, and project reports are for in-library use only.
- Silence is mandatory. Mobile phones must be silent.
- E-books and digital library access are encouraged to reduce paper consumption.
- Damaging books results in replacement + 20% penalty.
- Sustainable use of resources is emphasized—switch off lights/fans when not in use.

## COMPUTER LAB USAGE

Usage only with permission and for academic work. Prohibited: Accessing inappropriate content, downloading media, chatting, gaming. **Printing is restricted** to academic use; students are encouraged to adopt **paperless submission** where possible. Keep systems and environment clean; no food or drink allowed.

## GENERAL DISCIPLINE

Mobile phones are banned inside academic blocks.

- Vandalism
- Theft
- Harassment
- Substance abuse
- Littering

will invite strict action including suspension or rustication.

Respect for environment: Use dustbins, avoid single-use plastic, and participate in campus cleanliness drives. Behaviour must reflect mutual respect, gender sensitivity, and civic sense.

## ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

Ragging is banned as per Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 and UGC Regulations 2009.

Includes mental, physical, verbal abuse, or forced activities.

## Offenders face:

- Suspension
- FIR & legal action
- Expulsion from college
- An Anti-Ragging Cell.

## EXAMINATION CONDUCT

ID card and dress code compulsory.

Mobiles not allowed inside exam hall.

Use of unfair means is punishable as per SPPU regulations.

Use recycled paper wherever possible for rough work and notes.

## SUSTAINABILITY GUIDELINES

- PIMSE actively promotes environmental awareness and sustainability by integrating it into student conduct:
- Zero-litter policy across campus.
- Students must participate in tree plantations, waste management, clean energy awareness, and recycling initiatives.
- Green events: No thermocol or single-use plastics allowed.
- Encouragement of cycle-to-campus, carpooling, & public transport.
- Conservation of water and electricity is a shared responsibility.

## GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL

- An empowered Grievance Redressal Cell is in place.
- Students may report academic or behavioral issues confidentially.
- Gender sensitization, minority welfare, and inclusion are core focus areas.
- Whistleblowers are protected against retaliation.

## CLASSROOM & CAMPUS ETHICS

- Minimum 75% attendance is compulsory.
- Mutual respect toward faculty and classmates is mandatory.
- Students must maintain decorum during seminars, workshops, and external visits.
- Participation in CSR and environmental programs is encouraged.

## ETHICAL & PROFESSIONAL OUTLOOK

Students are expected to:

- Demonstrate **professional integrity, punctuality, and empathy**.
- Refrain from spreading misinformation, cyber bullying, or misconduct on **social media**.
- Embrace **green thinking and ethical leadership** in all academic and extracurricular activities.

## FINAL NOTE

Violation of this Code shall invite disciplinary action from the Director's Office, up to suspension or rustication depending on the nature and gravity of misconduct.

This Code of Conduct is reviewed annually in consultation with faculty, students, and regulatory updates to ensure continuous alignment with national guidelines and global best practices on sustainability and education ethics.

# ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The candidate should fulfill the following eligibility criteria:

Appeared/Passed with minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (45% in case of candidates of backward class categories and Persons with disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) in any Bachelor's degree awarded by any of the Universities incorporated by an Act of the Central or State Legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 of minimum three years duration in any discipline recognised by the Association of Indian Universities, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India.

Candidate should have

- Appeared and secured a positive non zero score in MH MBA CET (conducted by DTE) or CMAT (Conducted by AICTE)
- OR
- Appeared and secured a positive non zero score in CAT (conducted by IIMs)/ JMEL (conducted by IITs)/ MAT (Conducted by AIMA)/ XAT (conducted by XLRI)/ ATMA (conducted by AIMS).

Eligible candidates can seek admission through CAP rounds (Centralised Admission Process) conducted by DTE or they can apply for admissions under Minority seats/ Institute level seats/ against vacant seats.
